Those candidates, who got selected for Admissions at SRM Medical College Hospital and Research Centre, Kattankulathur, should report to the Dean, between 09:00 am to 04:00 pm as per the Schedule for All India Counseling (Allotment Process) For NEET Super Speciality Courses (D.M/ M.Ch & DNB SS) – 2024 issued by MCC of DGHS.

8. MBBS Attempt Certificate from the Head of the Institution/ College.
9. MBBS Internship Completion Certificate.
10. MBBS Course Completion/ Conduct Certificate issued by the Head of the Institution/ College.
11. MBBS Degree Certificate.
12. Permanent Registration Certificate of MBBS issued by MCI/State Medical Council.
13. MD/ MS Mark Sheet.
14. MD/ MS Attempt Certificate.
15. MD/MS Course Completion/ Conduct Certificate issued by the Head of the Institution/ College.
16. MD/MS/DNB Degree Certificate in the concerned Specialty.
17. Permanent Registration Certificate of MD/MS/DNB issued by MCI or NBE/State Medical Council. Students who have completed/are completing post-graduation by 30th April, of the year of admission are eligible to apply with provisional certificate.
The cut-off date for qualifying MD/MS/DNB Broad Specialty for appearing in NEET-SS counselling 2024 shall be 30th April 2025.
18. Migration Certificate from the respective University.
19. Transfer Certificate from the Head of the Institution/ College.
20. Ten Passport size photographs (Same as affixed on the NEET Application form)
21. Proof of Identity: AADHAR Card
22. PAN Card.
23. Community Certificate (if OBC/SC/ST)

- a) SC/ST Certificate issued by the competent authority (in the format as specified in the prospectus) and should be in English if it is in other than English and English version of the same should be submit Sub caste should be clearly mentioned in the certificate.
- b) OBC certificate issued by the competent authority. The sub-caste should tally with the Central List of OBC. The OBC candidates should not belong to Creamy Layer. The OBC certificate must be in the format as mentioned in the prospectus.
- c) Disability Certificate issued from a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board for 21 Benchmark Disabilities as per the Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016. No other PH certificate, issued by any other Authorities/ Hospital will be entertained. Refer MCC (Medical Counseling Committee) Website Notification for related information.

Candidates without original certificates/documents shall not be allowed to take admission in allotted Medical College. Candidates who have deposited their original documents with any other Institute/ College/University and come for admission with a certificate stating that "Candidates original certificates are deposited with the Institute/College/University" shall not be allowed to take admission in allotted Medical College.

Allotment letter given by DGHS for admission is subject to fulfilment of all eligibility criteria prescribed by the NMC and Medical fitness of the candidates. Those who do not fulfil the prescribed eligibility criteria and not found medically fit will not be admitted to the course of study to which they are allotted by the DGHS.

General Information for Candidates:

1. If a candidate fails to report within the date and time specified by MCC of DGHS in the allotment order along with the original Certificates/Documents and/or fails to pay the tuition fee as specified by the Institution in this document, he/she will not be permitted to proceed with the admission process. The vacancy arising there from will be duly notified to the MCC of DGHS.
2. If any candidate withdraws from the course of study in which he/she was admitted, after the expiry of the cut-off date prescribed by MCC of DGHS for admission to that course of study or in mid-term or at any point during their time of study and the seat is rendered

vacant, the fee paid till then will be forfeited and the student will also be required to remit the “entire course fee” for the remaining years of the course period.

3. Students will be governed by all the University rules including rules for refund of fee, disciplinary rules, hostel rules and UGC/NMC Regulations for Curbing the Menace of Ragging etc. At the time of admission, candidates should sign declaration/undertaking declaring that they shall abide by all the rules and regulations of the University including and not limited to anti-ragging Regulations of the UGC/NMC and observe good conduct and behaviour.
4. All disputes arising in the interpretation and implementation of the provisions listed above will be referred to the Vice-Chancellor of SRM Institute of Science and Technology (Deemed to be University) and the Vice-Chancellor’s decision shall be final and binding.
